Importation of Turkish Ibuprofen for Children up to 11 years (Orange Flavour) due to the current shortage of Canadian-authorized Pediatric Analgesic Products

As the country experiences increased consumer-driven demand for ibuprofen products for infants and children, manufacturers are taking all possible measures to ensure product availability, however a shortage continues to be experienced in Canada.

Health Canada has permitted the exceptional, temporary importation and sale of ibuprofen products under the brand name Pedifen[®] which is manufactured and licenced in Turkey, by Atabay Pharmaceuticals and Fine Chemicals (Atabay Ilac Fabrikasi, A.S.), a pharmaceutical manufacturer that already produces and exports active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs) for the Canadian market. This product for children up to 11 years is permitted for sale and distribution to hospitals and retail outlets **in Alberta only**.

Communication for Pharmacists:

Health Canada has permitted the exceptional, temporary importation and sale of ibuprofen products under the brand name Pedifen[®] which is manufactured and licenced in Turkey, by Atabay Pharmaceuticals and Fine Chemicals (Atabay Ilac Fabrikasi, A.S.), a pharmaceutical manufacturer that already produces and exports active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs) for the Canadian market. This product for children up to 11 years is permitted for sale and distribution to hospitals and retail outlets **in Alberta only**.

In order to adequately communicate information to purchasers/caregivers, pharmacists should be aware that Pedifen[®] is sold with different inactive ingredients, including sunset yellow E110 dye and a different dosing device with different graduations. Note, this product is alcohol free. Please see Appendices for pictures of the labels and dosing devices.

The Pedifen[®] product has some of the **same** product characteristics as the Canadian-authorized product that are relevant to the end user, including active ingredient, dosage form, indications, dosing instructions and route of administration. The product, however, **differs** in the following ways: brand, flavour, container, inactive ingredients, dosing device, and storage. These differences may lead to allergies or hypersensitivities that should be considered and monitored as part of patient assessment, counselling, monitoring and follow up.

Healthcare professionals are advised that aspects of the inner and outer labels and packaging of the Pedifen[®] branded product may differ from current pediatric products in Canada. Proper selection of the intended product must be verified to avoid confusion with other products and prevent medication errors.

Dosing and Directions for Use

The concentration of this product is 100 mg/5mL, which is the same concentration as the product on the Canadian market; therefore, a single dosage and the maximum daily dosage aligns with Canadian products. Please use the chart below and dose based on weight. Repeat dose every 6-8 hours while symptoms last. Do not give more than 4 times in 24 hours. Do not take more than directed. The dosing device provided with the product allows for the measure of 1.25mL (base of the spoon), 2.5mL (first line) and 5mL (full spoon) aliquots. See Appendix 2 for a picture of the dosing spoon.


